

Outstanding Contribution to Women in Policing



- To be awarded to an individual who has made an outstanding contribution to women in policing
- The award is designed to enable all Federated officers, or recently retired Federated officers, to be recognised and nominated for their work
- It must be evidenced that the nominee has gone above and beyond their core duty and made a difference that has led to a profound positive impact on others
- Nominations will open on 10 March 2021 and close on 30 April 2021
- Nominations can be made by any member of PFEW, representative of PFEW – local Branch Boards/Council/National Board - or any member of support staff
- Evidence meeting the criteria for the award must be submitted with the nomination form
- The awards body will meet to examine, discuss, and judge the nominations to select the overall winner in May 2021
- The judgement of the awards body in selecting the recipient will be final and not open to challenge or appeal
- The winner will be notified and presented with the award at PFEW's Annual Conference on 9 June 2021
- All submissions must be submitted to your local Branch Board for approval. Final submission should be sent for the attention of Claire Blekkenhorst at pfevents@polfed.org

Criteria

- Nominees:
 - must be serving, or recently retired, officers of a Federated rank
 - can be male, female or the gender in which they identify
 - must have demonstrated how they have made an impact on, and significant contribution to, women in policing
- Nominators can be police officers or members of support staff
- The final date for submissions is 30 April 2021
